

**Public Workshop Planned for the Route 81 Corridor Study

**Clinton, CT-** The Town of Clinton, with support from the Lower Connecticut River Valley Council of Governments (RiverCOG) and the Connecticut Department of Transportation, is conducting a study focused on the Route 81 corridor, between Route 1 and Rocky Ledge Drive. This study will address current and future travel, economic development, and quality of life along Route 81.

In support of this study, a Public Workshop will be conducted on Monday, June 25<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 pm in the Cafeteria of The Morgan School, 71 Killingworth Turnpike, Clinton. The workshop will be preceded by an open house at 5:30 pm.
