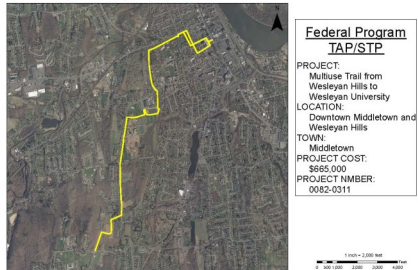


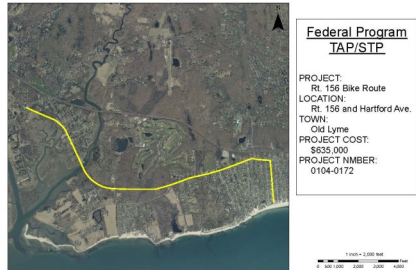

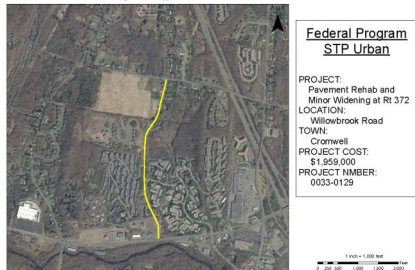
Transportation Improvement Program

2015 - 2018 TIP

In accordance with the provisions of Title 23, section 134 of the United States code; as amended by the Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century Act (MAP-21) enacted on July 6, 2012; the Lower Connecticut River Valley COG (LCRVCOG) has developed a draft Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The TIP lists all federally funded transportation improvements, by federal funding category which are scheduled to occur over the next four years. It includes capital and operational improvements to the various modes, which make up the transportation system, including highway, bus, rail and bicycle facilities. The TIP is used to implement the goals and objectives identified in the Long-Range Regional Transportation Plan.

The LCRVCOG is the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the towns of Chester, Clinton, Cromwell, Deep River, Durham, East Haddam, East Hampton, Essex, Killingworth, Lyme, Middlefield, Middletown, Old Lyme, Old Saybrook, Portland, and Westbrook.

Public Information Meeting

On October 2, 2014, an informational meeting will be held at the Lower Connecticut River Valley Council of Governments, 145, Dennison Road, Essex, Connecticut. The meeting will begin promptly at 5:00 p. m.. The meeting will provide a forum for a full and open discussion of the Draft 2015 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). At the meeting, the public will have an opportunity to review, comment and discuss on any aspect of the TIP. This forum will also provide the COG with information from the public regarding their desires and concerns. COG staff will be available one-half hour prior to the meeting to informally discuss the TIP. They will answer specific questions about any of the proposed projects. Please use this meeting as an opportunity to ask questions and provide input to these very important transportation planning efforts.

The Ozone Air Quality Conformity Determination and Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) will also be available for review and comment and CTDOT staff will be in attendance to answer any questions. The STIP is a compilation of all the regional TIP's in the state.

Public notice of the TIP also meets the Public notice requirements of the Estuary Transit District and Middletown Transit District Program of Projects (POP).

Review Procedure

The draft 2015 TIP will be available for review for a thirty day public comment period between September 15, 2014 and October 15, 2014.
