Draft FY 2018-2019 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)

May 1, 2017

The Lower Connecticut River Valley Council of Governments (RiverCOG) has initiated a thirty day public comment period for the draft 2018-2019 UPWP. The UPWP is the transportation planning program that identifies tasks initiated by RiverCOG for the period between July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2019. It includes descriptions of planning tasks and products, identifies who will perform the tasks, a schedule for completing the tasks, and the cost of work and source of funds to maintain a federally compliant metropolitan planning organization (MPO) transportation planning process for the RiverCOG region.

This comment period provides the public and opportunity to comment on the draft 2018-2019 UPWP through May 30, 2017. A public information meeting will be held on Thursday May 18, 2017 at 5:00 p.m. at the RiverCOG office located at 145 Dennison Road, Essex CT 06426.
