Requirements:

Background, interest, or course work in digital media, content creation, marketing, or related field

Experience with video productions and editing (portfolio or video examples helpful)

Candidates will need to have access to their own recording and media editing equipment (this could be a smart phone & laptop). Software licenses for Adobe Creative Suite can be provided.

Familiarity with Adobe Premiere, Adobe Photoshop, Canva, GIMP, or similar graphic design and media editing tools such as Da Vinci Resolve

Strong communication and storytelling skills

Ability to meet deadlines and work independently at times

Technicalities:

~10 - 20 hours per week (not to exceed 20 hours per week)

\$17 per hour

The ideal candidate will be available to work mostly on-site in our office in Essex, CT, though some editing and other work can be done from home
